

Understanding Endodontic-Periodontal Involvement: Etiology, Diagnosis and Treatment Solutions.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Pulp pathosis may affect periodontal tissues and vice versa. Teeth with isolated endodontic or periodontal lesions have a better prognosis than those with a combined involvement. Endodontic and periodontal prognosis assessment is critical for a successful restorative outcome. This presentation covers methodical approaches for assessing etiologic factors, diagnostic mechanisms and treatment modalities to predicably navigate through Endodontic-Periodontal lesions. Clinical case scenarios are presented to treat different examples of Endodontic-Periodontal lesions with emphasis on interdisciplinary approach.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Understand etiologic factors affecting the pulp and periodontium.
2. Employ a methodical diagnostic approach for a more predictable prognosis.
3. Recognize when it is appropriate to consider treatment of these “compromised” teeth or opt for an extraction and replacement alternatives.
4. Be familiar with non-surgical and surgical treatment options.
